In the "Inter House Football Tournament", the Red House jointly secured the 2nd place with the Green House in the Senior Category while making its way to the 1st place in the Junior as well as the Sub-Junior Category. Players who deserve a round of applause are Suyash Srivastava(12C), Mohd. Arkaan Khan(11B), Yash Srivastava(12A), Sangyan Singh(12C) and Aishwary(12C).
