Most of the credit goes to Stavya Agarwal, the person who not only won in various house aquatics competitions, but also represented the

state of UP and UK in the National Level Swimming Competition. All of this led to Blue House coming second in Aquatics.

The seniors showed exceptional skill and teamwork, and with the help of these valuable players Adduaye Yadav, Sanskar Saxena, Unnayan Shukla, Reyan Khan, S.M.

Khubaib Noori, and Umar Shujat, St. Andrew's House stood second in the Senior Category. The juniors also showed their might throughout the court, which led to them bagging the first position in the Junior Category.

- 4. **Speech Competition:** Our talented speakers, Shayaan Zaman and Pranav Tripathi, delivered stellar performances that captivated the judges. Their outstanding performance, marked by confidence, eloquence, and intellectual depth, earned St. Andrew's House a well-deserved second position, showcasing the exceptional talent and dedication of our members.
