Volleyball: We stepped in the competitive mode on 23rd April 2024 for the first Inter-house Competition for the year, the Inter-House Volleyball Competition. In our first and second matches, we defeated the Blue and the Green Houses by clean wins of 2-0 securing the 2nd position through the efforts of Shreyash Gupta, Lakshya Agarwal, Mayank Singh, Abhigyan, Rudra Dutt Dubey, and Arishh Abraaham Aalam.
