Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Matches will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI). However, certain rules may be modified to suit local requirements and circumstances.
2. All matches will be played on a league basis in the T-20 format.
3. Each team shall consist of 16 members, including a wicketkeeper.
4. Matches will be played with white balls for the Junior and Senior categories, while a tennis ball will be used for the Sub-Junior category. Players must wear their respective House T-shirts along with white track pants in the Junior, Senior, and Sub-Junior categories.
5. Each match shall consist of:
15 overs per innings for the senior category,
12 overs per innings for the junior category, and
8 overs per innings for the sub-Junior category.
6. The winning team shall be awarded 2 points, while the losing team shall receive no points.
7. In case of a tie, a Super Over will be played. If the result remains unresolved, subsequent Super overs will be played until a winner is determined.
8. **Super over Regulations:**
 - a) A player dismissed in a previous Super Over shall not bat again. The bowler from the immediately preceding Super Over shall not bowl the next Super Over.
 - b) The team that batted second in the previous Super Over shall bat first in the subsequent Super Over.
9. **Match Abandonment (Weather/Other Interruptions):**
 - ✓ **Sufficient Play:** If the team batting second has completed the minimum required overs (**4 overs in a 15-over match, 3 overs in a 12-over match, and 2 overs in an 8-over match**), the **Duckworth-Lewis-Stern method** will be applied. The winner will be determined based on the par score at the time of interruption.
 - ✓ **Insufficient Play:** If the match is abandoned before the minimum required overs are completed by the team batting second, the match shall be declared a "No Result" and will be replayed.
10. After completion of the league matches, the team securing the highest number of points shall be declared the winner of the tournament. The remaining teams will be ranked accordingly based on their total points.
11. If two teams finish with an equal number of points, the overall run rate from all their matches will be considered. The team with the higher run rate shall be ranked higher.
12. If two teams still have the same run rate, the result of their head-to-head match in the league stage will determine the winner.
13. House Masters and team captains shall be responsible for maintaining discipline. Any act of misconduct or use of indecent language towards umpires, players, or other participants will invite strict disciplinary action.
14. The captain must submit the list of 12 players (including the 12th man) to the umpire before the toss. No changes to this list shall be permitted thereafter.
15. **Each bowler may bowl a maximum of:**
 - ✓ 3 overs in the senior category, and
 - ✓ 2 overs in the junior category.
 - ✓ 2 overs in the Sub - junior category.
16. **The decision of the umpire(s) shall be final and binding on all teams.**
